Saint Cloch is a gallery and cafe space located in Sydney's inner suburb of Paddington.

On a busy corner amongst traditional Paddington terrace houses, an existing 1980's shopfront has been reimagined with steel and glass doors opening onto a terrace. The interior palette of polished concrete floors, white plaster walls and Carrara marble create a simple background for changing artworks and installations. Monolithic plinths in gloss black, Carrara marble, brass and neolith tile, allow varied configurations for exhibitions and events.

A secondary space houses a Carrara marble bar that operates as a cafe during the day and as a service bar during exhibition openings.
